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Accounting Contest 2021 **Important CHANGES**

The OBEA Accounting Contests for Grade 11 and 12 students will take place on Wednesday, May 19, 2021. There will be a Practice Contest on Wednesday, May 12, 2021. Registration is now open for both Contests. Due to unforeseen circumstances, please note that there have been several changes to both the BAF and BAT Contests.

In the event of a further lockdown resulting in online learning, **Students will be able to complete the Contest from their home the same way as last year**

Start and end times will be as follows:

Grade 11: Start Time: 10:00 a.m. to End Time: 11:30 a.m. Grade 12: Start Time: 1:00 p.m. to End Time: 2:30 p.m.

Students are to be registered online through the OBEA Website for these Contests; paper forms are not necessary.

Also please note that students must have a teacher-sponsor from their school that is a current member of OBEA through May 31, 2021.

As in the past for both Contests, **BAF3M1** and **BAT4M1**, there will be a five-person-per-section limit. **Registration closes on Thursday**, **May 6**, **2021**. Please refer to the Contest Handbook for further details on how to register your students.
